

# Admission July 2020

## Master of Computer Applications (MCA)

**Eligibility:** Any Bachelor's degree of minimum 3 (three) year duration from a recognized University AND Mathematics as one of the subject at 10+2 level or graduation level; else the student is required to pursue and pass the BCS12 course concurrently with IGNOU MCA.

**Medium of Instruction:** English

**Duration:** Minimum 3 years and Maximum 6 years;

**Fee Structure:** Rs. 72,000/- for full programme to be paid semester wise @Rs. 12000/- per semester. Non Maths students have to pay Rs.1,400/- additional in the first semester.

## Bachelor of Computer Applications (BCA)

**Eligibility:** 10+2 or its equivalent

**Medium of Instruction:** English

**Duration:** Minimum 3 years and Maximum 6 years; offered in both January & July cycle of admissions.

**Fee Structure:** Rs. 40,200/- for full programme to be paid Semester wise @Rs. 6,700/- per semester

## PG Diploma In Computer Applications (PGDCA)

**Eligibility:** Any Bachelor's degree of minimum 03 (three) years duration from a recognized University AND Mathematics as one of the subject at 10+2 level or graduation level; else the student is required to pursue and pass the BCS-012 course concurrently with PGDCA.

**Medium of Instruction :** English

**Duration :** Minimum 1 year and Maximum 4 years; offered in both January & July cycle of admissions.

**Fee Structure :** Rs. 21,600/- for full Programme to be paid semester wise @Rs.10800/- per semester. Non-Maths students have to pay Rs.1400/- additional in the first semester.

## Certificate in Information Technology (CIT)

**Eligibility:** 10th Pass OR SSC OR BPP from IGNOU OR DLC from Microsoft or equivalent

**Medium of Instruction:** English

**Duration:** Minimum 6 months and Maximum 2 years; offered in both January & July cycle of admissions.

**Fee Structure:** Rs.6,000/- for full programme
